

Constitution Day Policy

In accordance with the Congressional initiative as authorized by Section 111 of Division J of Pub. L 108-447 and as required by The Assistant Deputy Secretary for Innovation and Improvement, every year, on September 17th, Zion Massage College commemorates and honors Constitution Day, the ratification and signing of the US Constitution. ZMC celebrates this day through learning activities, discussions, handouts and/or educational videos. If September 17th falls on a Saturday or Sunday, ZMC will hold the Constitution Day commemoration and educational activities on the 1st Monday following the September 17th date.

ZMC keeps a historical record of the activities and educational presentations offered to students to commemorate Constitution Day.
