

ZMC Job Placement Rates

Placement Rates at Zion Massage College are obtained through calculating the number of graduates who obtained employment in the field divided by the total number of graduates between January 1st to December 31st of the same year. Zion Massage College reports its Job Placement Rates to COMTA (Commission on Massage Therapy Accreditation) annually on February 1st.

Zion Massage College does offer training in interviewing skills, resume and cover letter writing, development of professional behavior and boundaries in the workplace, and much more. Students are taken on tours of various employers throughout St. George and given the opportunity to network as well as understand the various job opportunities available to them. The school also posts a listing of all employers, sends employment opportunities out to all graduates, and offers lifetime employment guidance. Zion Massage College offers lifetime assistance with post graduate employment needs including assistance with licensing in other states.
