Emergency Response Protocol for Acts of Terrorism at Zion Massage College:

1. Immediate Response:
 - Remain calm and alert all staff members and students of the potential threat.
 - If possible, contact local law enforcement authorities to report the situation and provide any relevant information.
 - Activate the building's response notification by texting or calling Rebecca Farraway (435-216-8512) or Christina Frantzen (760-574-6867) so that they can alert occupants of the threat and initiate evacuation procedures.
2. Evacuation Procedure:
 - Follow the established evacuation routes and procedures posted in each classroom and main office area.
 - Exit the building quickly and calmly, avoiding congested areas and potential hazards.
 - Assist anyone who may require help to evacuate, ensuring that all occupants are safely evacuated from the premises.
3. Assembly Point:
 - Proceed to the designated assembly point, which is located at the public bus stop on the edge of the Green Valley Market parking lot on Valley View Dr.
 - Account for all staff members and students to ensure that everyone has evacuated safely.
4. Shelter-in-Place:
 - If evacuation is not possible or safe, shelter-in-place in a secure location within the building.
 - Close and lock all doors and windows, and turn off lights to make the area less visible from the outside.
 - Stay low to the ground to minimize exposure to potential threats.
5. Communication:
 - Maintain communication with local law enforcement authorities and emergency responders to provide updates on the situation and receive instructions.
 - Keep staff members and students informed of developments and any necessary actions to take.
6. First Aid and Medical Assistance:
 - Administer first aid to anyone who may be injured or in need of medical assistance.
 - Contact emergency medical services to request assistance for any serious injuries or medical emergencies.
7. Follow-Up Actions:
 - Cooperate fully with law enforcement authorities and emergency responders during their investigation and response efforts.
 - Provide support and assistance to affected staff members and students, including counseling services if necessary.
 - Conduct a thorough review and debriefing of the emergency response procedures following the incident to identify any areas for improvement.
